## **Tenesia Brown – Key Realty Group (KRG)**

Small Business and Non-Profit Grant Application Process.

ARPA (American Rescue Plan Act) is a relief fund that was created in response to the economic impact that Covid had on the United States. City of Jennings is expected to receive \$2.9 million dollars of these funds. As of today, City of Jennings has received half of these funds. Ms. Shelton went over the uses of the ARPA funds for households, small business, and non-profit organizations.
